BAPTISM OF THE LORD "C"

"THIS IS MY BELOVED SON": The feast of the Baptism of the Lord, ends the season of Christmas. Baptism is the first of the seven sacraments of the Church. This feast retells the beginning of Jesus' ministry. Jesus is baptized by John. The Spirit descends upon Jesus. The voice calls Jesus "beloved." As the voice of God proclaims Jesus to be the "beloved," we can hear God affirming that same wonderful reality to all of us human creatures. There is a wonderful dignity in the life of every human person. All of creation shares in this dignity as well. This Spirit, which descends upon Jesus, is not just about Jesus, just as our baptism is not just about our personal relationship with God. We are part of something bigger than ourselves. We are baptized into a community. We are baptized into a set of shared values and a commitment to the common good. This Spirit of Jesus is about opening the eyes of the blind and releasing people from captivity. It is about service to those in need, care for those who are poor, political and economic justice, and a respect for creation. We see in the baptism of Jesus a call to deepen our baptismal call and renew our own values and ways of living and to recommit ourselves to the way of Jesus.



SYMBOLS OF BAPTISM: Immersion in water symbolises not only death and purification, but also regeneration and renewal. The **white garment** represents the new life in Christ; the **oil** symbolises the anointing into the ministry of Jesus (priest, prophet & king). The **lit candle** represents the light of Christ in our lives, guiding us and inviting us to be light for others.
