

"BLESSED IS SHE WHO BELIEVED": The Gospel today describes what is commonly called "The Visitation" - the coming together of two women to acknowledge the action of God in their lives. Mary, a young girl from an obscure village in Palestine, becomes the mother of God. Elizabeth's words of greeting to Mary remind us that faith is firstly a gift of God. Elizabeth knew by an intuition from God about her cousin and the child she was bearing - no person had explained the circumstances to her. This is symbolised by the leaping of her own unborn child, John, inside her. God uses those who are small and powerless to bring about salvation. Luke's Gospel pays a great deal of attention to the role of women in the story of salvation. Mary has a unique and integral place in the Christian tradition. Catholics honour her because of her openness to listen to God's Word. Mary trusted in God even when things seemed incomprehensible or impossible.


